Paris Agreement

- *A legally binding, universal agreement*
- *189 nationally determined contributions (NDCs)*
- *Ambitious long-term goals*
- *Dynamic 5-year ambition cycle*
- *Enhanced transparency and accountability*
- *Greater emphasis on adaptation*
- *Support for poor and vulnerable countries*

EU assessment of the Paris Agreement

- **2015 December European Council invited the Commission and the Council to assess the Paris Agreement and to prepare the next steps**
- **Commission Communication discussed in the Environment Council and European Council in March**

Road from Paris actions

- **Energy Union transition**
- **Innovation and competitiveness**
- **Investment and capital markets**
- **Carbon pricing and fossil fuel subsidies**
- **Civil society and smart cities**
- **Climate diplomacy and global action**
- **2030 energy and climate regulatory framework**

Future regulatory steps

2016:

- **Effort sharing decision**
- **Land use, land-use change and forestry**
- **Decarbonisation of transport**
- **Security of gas and electricity supply**
- **Renewable energy and sustainability of biomass**
- **Energy efficiency including buildings**

2017:

- **Further proposals on transport**
