EURACOAL's tasks

- Regular information on all matters relevant to coal
- Forum for members
- Concentration of energy and coal policy interests at European level
- Cooperation in shaping policy and legal framework
- Extension of the information of and contact with EU
 Commission and EU Parliament
- Cooperation with politicians, associations, etc., in Brussels

Coal interests in the European Environment and Energy Policy

- EU Measures for Implementing the Kyoto Protocol
- Directive on the Management of Waste from the Extractive Industry
- Groundwater Directive
- Communication from the Commission towards a Thematic Strategy for Soil Protection
- Chemicals legislation (REACH-System)
- Environmental Liability Directive
- Directive on Public Access to Environmental Information, Public Participation in Decision-Making and Access to Justice in Environmental Matters

Community Acts

- Regulations directly applicable in all Member States
- Directives binding, as to the result to be achieved, but leaves the Member States the choice of form and methods
- Decisions binding upon those to whom it is adressed
- Recommendations and opinions no binding force

Procedures (I)

Assent procedure

- Requires the Council to obtain EP's assent before certain important decisions are taken.
- Examples
 - accession of new Member States
 - appointment of the President of the Commission
 - procedure for EP elections
 - tasks and statutes of the European Central Bank


Procedures (II)

Consultation procedure

■ EP gives its opinion on a proposal from the Commission


Co-decision Procedure

- Gives EP the power to adopt instruments jointly with the Council e. g. in the following fields:
 - Environment
 - Internal Market
 - Consumer Protection
 - Trans European Networks
 - Statistics
 - Research (Framework Programme)



Co-decision procedure - second phase




Co-decision procedure third phase 6 (+ 2) weeks 6 (+ 2) weeks European Parliament third reading

Conciliation Committee

- 15 Council members, as a general rule the representatives within Coreper
- 15 EP members appointed by the political groups
- Commission as a rule represented by the Commissioner resposible for the matter; takes all necessary initiatives
- before the meetings: preparatory meeting of each delegation, followed by a formal trialogue (Commissioner + the two chairmen)
